

# SGQG Final Business Meeting Notes

March 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by Acting President Penny Dominici, with board member Barbara Miller, Treasurer, and Debby Sweeten, Acting Secretary, in attendance.

## **Announcements, Communications and Committee Reports:**

Penny announced several upcoming quilt shows from flyers we received.

We received a thank you note from Friends of the Library for a book donation. We also received a thank you for our monetary donation.

There was a discussion on receipts. Everyone needs to provide documentation for all requested reimbursements. If the reimbursement is for the quilt show, please either pick up a 2017 Quilt Show reimbursement form from Barb Miller or make a notation (in red) at the top of the reimbursement form that says “2017 Quilt Show”. The treasurer tracks the quilt show expenses separately from the regular expenses.

Penny reviewed the list of workshops coming up this year. In June, Jenny Lyon will be making kits for her workshop. Sign-ups are on the workshop table.

Mary Foster discussed the 2017 opportunity quilt. There are still tickets for people to pick up. The opportunity quilt travelled to Santa Rosa the beginning of March. It is scheduled to travel to Grass Valley in June.

Mary discussed chemo caps. There are lots of kits available to pick up. Mary Nahhas will take children’s caps to Stanford.

Mary brought boxes of fabric from a friend. If you pick some fabric, please consider a donation for the fabric. The money will be donated to STARS and chemo caps.

The quilt show co-chairs (Debby, Louise and Erika) and Anita McGee-Hunt discussed the country store, basket raffle and the next cutting party. The next cutting party is March 28 at the Pine Grove Mobile Home Estates clubhouse. A sign-up sheet for the baskets was passed around.

Barbara Garcia (publicity for the quilt show) now has quilt show posters available. Debby emailed everyone the poster. Pass them around to everyone. She plans to start putting posters up in the county in August.

Julie Broderson discussed a donation quilt for the Interfaith Food Bank. She and Pat had put out a request for a raffle quality donation quilt. Mary Ann Engelbrekton provided a quilt for the raffle. She had taken a class from Barbara Heard and had recently finished the quilt. Thank you to Mary Ann. There was further discussion about having a few donation quilts on hand for giving to groups.

Small quilt auction – 3 small quilts were handed in today for the quilt show. Penny asked if there were other small quilts – several other small quilts are in the process of being finished.

Saturday March 18 is National Quilt Day.

**Minutes** – the minutes from the February meeting were posted on the SGQG website. Clara Scholl motioned for the minutes to be approved as posted. Lannie Staniford 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. The guild members voted to approve the minutes as posted.

**Treasurer's Report**: There was a balance of \$13,457.96 as of the end of February.

Janis Beach discussed some community quilts that Chris Zeterburg quilted. She asked if they belonged to anyone in this guild. It was suggested that we put pictures in the newsletter to see if anyone recognizes them.

Hilde Langlet discussed the quilt challenge for the quilt show. The theme is butterflies. There is more information in the newsletter. She asked if the challenge quilts are turned in early for the quilt show. Yes – they need to be turned in early.

**Raffle**: Hilde Langlet and Barbara Garcia went over the raffle items for today.

**Round Robin quilts** – Susan Farrington – acting for Pat Bjerke - had everyone show their Round Robin quilt tops. Then everyone exchanged their quilt tops for a different quilt top.

Susan raffled off several Round Robin quilt tops. The winners this month were: Pat Carr, Iola Gibbs and Sandy Askin (2x).
